

MVLL Board Meeting Minutes
March 4, 2019

- Interleague Play- Mike Dittus and Pat Magee from Kingston Little League were present to discuss possible scheduling of interleague games. Kingston is getting soft ball together and wondered if our league might have any players that would want to join
- Keith brought up a separate 8-9 year old, thinking that it is a good idea to help focus on development. Mike said Kingston is trying 4-5 year old tee-ball, 6-7 year old rookie and 8-9 minors - discussed get MVLL and Kingston 8-9 year olds together for development - Summer ball possibilities?
- We will look into scheduling weekend games with Kingston once both registrations are complete. Eric proposed working a complete schedule rather than just a tournament . MVLL & Kingston will meet April 2, 7pm at Hickory Bbq to discuss scheduling games
- Pete was not present but sent an email to LJ - Current balance at \$17,083- \$1866 from registration and \$70 from sales at the clinics
- LJ needs to order catcher gloves and bats, we have knee savers
- LJ advised that the Little League grant is slighted for a September payout, so it will be going towards next year's budget
- Current registrations at 40 majors, 37 minors and 14 tee ball - We are waiting for 44 players in order to make 4 teams for majors, 4 teams for minors
- Tee ball clinic - LJ said we were waiting on a schedule, Bennett is only available if the High School declines or is booked

- Rules and guidelines for majors and minors - how to deal with enough play time for all players, discussed benching time vs play time, more experience vs less experience, board decided Little League rules will stand
- Draft rules - everyone will be evaluated A, B or C players, coach's children will count as 1st pick, pitchers will be picked, 1 pick goes last for next pick, after draft any late registration, team placement will be decided by board through email, special circumstances such as transportation will be accommodated
- Coaches safety meeting - looking to schedule in the 1st 2 weeks of April - all coaches should be present to discuss rules and regulations - we will try to schedule the Bennett Cafeteria, equipment handout with MVLL stickers on bags
- Uniforms - LJ discussed looking for bids, we priced some examples online, board voted approved ordering through ICL Customs -
