

Mountain Valley Little League Covid-19 Guidelines

All players, parents/spectators and coaches are required to follow these guidelines to ensure a successful and safe 2021 season. A supply of hand sanitizer will always be on premises and face masks will be available for anyone who does not have one. Only one person is permitted in the bathroom and any one time, and cleaning of the bathrooms will be coordinated with the Towns of Olive, Shandaken, and Woodstock.

Concessions:

There will be <u>limited</u> concession stands at Grant Avery, Rick Volz, and Glenbrook Parks. They will <u>only</u> consist of pre-packaged foods and drinks. There will be no cooked or grilled of items available.

Umpire:

If an umpire is used, he/she will have temperature taken prior to stepping on the field. Umpires will be encouraged to bring their own equipment. If they need to be supplied the equipment, it will be sanitized prior to and after use.

Coaches:

All coaches will have their temperature taken prior to taking the field. All coaches must wear a mask the entire time. Only three adults (coaches) will be permitted for each team: one Manager and two base coaches. The Manager will remain in the dugout and the base coaches will be positioned 6ft from first and third base. When players are in the dugout one base coach will stay with players not in the dugout. (For Minors one coach is allowed in the field for the fielding team)

Players:

Once a player arrives their temperature will be checked. After that, the player will be assigned a seat in a dugout 6ft from others player. Players will be encouraged to bring their own equipment. Players are also encouraged to bring their own water bottle that is clearly labeled with their name. MVLL will not provide water for players.

Equipment:

All MVLL-supplied game equipment/gear will be wiped down with disinfecting wipes or spray before and after the games, as well as during gameplay after a player uses it. For example, after a player uses a bat the manger will sanitize the bat prior to another player using it. Players will be encouraged to bring their own equipment and to not share it with their friends on the team to ensure no cross contamination. Baseballs will be cycled regularly throughout the game and wiped down so that a sanitized ball is being used.

Spectators:

Masks are to be worn from exiting the vehicle until they have arrived at their seats. The only time masks can be removed will be where they are seated in their own lawn chairs. The Designated seating will be outside the fence only after the dugouts. If spectators get up and move, they must wear a mask. There are No Exceptions and zero tolerance for non-compliance.

Bleachers and Picnic tables will be taped off and will not be used by spectators. These areas may be used by players as designated seating if needed.

The area behind the Home team dugout, by the snack shack, will not be allowed as a permitted spectator seating area.

Enforcement:

A Mountain Valley Little League designee will take temperatures for the adults and children involved in the game.

A Mountain Valley Little League designee will patrol the game are to ensure that everyone is abiding by the guidelines.
